


Pain Ease is approved for needle procedures such as immunizations, injections, and IV starts.


Today is Tommy's first visit to the doctor's office. He doesn't know what to expect and he feels scared.



When Tommy and his Mom arrive, the doctor tells Tommy he has to get a shot. Oh no! Tommy hates shots!




But then, Chilly the Penguin waddles in. "I'm Chilly and I'm here to help make your shot hurt less," Chilly says.
